The Future of Arnolia United Methodist Church A Report from the Arnolia Leadership Team Craig Nickerson, Chair

On August 24, 1910, a group of people met at the home of Mr. John C. Dorfler in Baynesville for the purpose of forming a new Sunday School. The nearest church was three miles away, a long walk in those days, and they were anxious to worship closer to home. Over time, the group expanded, built several different buildings, and has grown into the Arnolia we know today.

Our history is filled with stories of transformation, growth, and change.

Our worshipping congregation is now below ninety people, our expenses continue to outpace our income, and it is becoming harder to find the volunteers needed to sustain our ministry in the community. Despite these difficulties, Arnolia continues to transform lives and fulfill our mission of making disciples for Jesus Christ. We are feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, and ministering to those in the prison of addiction. Our building is used by a preschool, an elementary school age science, technology, engineering, and math program, a children's choir, and our thrift store provides reasonably priced (or no cost) clothing and household goods for the community. God is hard at work among us!

In 2023, we made the difficult decision to move to a three-quarters time pastor. Despite this move, our expenses have continued to rise while our income has not kept pace. For example, just like your BGE bill has increased so has Arnolia's, yet giving is not increasing at the same rate. We are also waiting to formulate search plans for the next Director of Music until we know our financial situation has improved. Please take a moment to prayerfully consider your financial support of Arnolia.

Given our situation, the Leadership Team is now faced with making additional difficult decisions. We believe Arnolia is about to go through another transformation. Regardless of where the transformation takes us, Arnolia will always have its identity and will continue to exist.

We are in a period of prayer and discernment as we decide whether we should enter a cooperative arrangement with one or more other United Methodist churches in our area for the purpose of pooling our resources, enhancing our shared ministries, and enabling us to further advance God's Kingdom in this world.

Today, we're asking every member of Arnolia to join with us in this effort of actively praying for our congregation and the Leadership Team as we discern our future. We are encouraging everyone to use this prayer in this process:

God, may your preferred will break through, change history, usher in and accomplish through us your new hopes, dreams and possibilities—both in the life of our church, and in our own lives. We surrender our wills for yours, in order to fully follow you. Amen.

The goal of the Leadership Team is to make a decision regarding our future direction in March, and then to work with resources from the Conference in April to shape our direction. We will provide more information to the congregation as the process unfolds and will bring final decisions regarding our future to the entire congregation for discussion.

The Leadership Team appreciates the support of everyone in the congregation, and we thank you for supporting us all in your prayers.

Backpack Buddies

DID YOU KNOW? That each week during the school year our Backpack Buddy volunteers meet at the church to prepare 12 Backpack bags, each with individual portions of microwaveable Compleats, Mac n Cheese, Chef Boyardee dinners and a carton of tuna/chicken salad with crackers. The bags also include an individual serving of shelf milk, a packet of instant oatmeal, a breakfast bar, veggie cup, a fruit cup, microwaveable popcorn packet and a snack such as cheese crackers, Rice Krispie Bar or pretzels slipped into the bags.

DID YOU KNOW? That in the next day or two after the bags are packed, Ralph Wilson or John Gorsuch will stop by the church to pick up the bags and deliver them to the elementary school. They are greeted warmly by the staff in the office, usually with a "Thank you" from one of the secretaries or a teacher who happens to be in the office at that time. The bags are put into a large storage container in the office storeroom, protecting the food from any inquisitive school mouse that might have snuck into the office in the middle of the night. The counselors who have determined which families could need food assistance, contact the families to ask if they would like the weekend meals for their child and if so, the bags are handed out to the students before the last school day of the week.

DID YOU KNOW? That the Backpack Buddies receive \$50 each month from Outreach (Arnolia's Thrift Store). But the largest portion of food this project depends on for its success each week are the donations of designated food YOU bring in and the monetary contributions YOU provide.

THANK YOU! Thank you for the heavy cartons of shelf milk or the one carton of tuna salad with crackers that you have brought to church and placed under the Communion Table. THANK YOU for the dozens of Chef Boyardee cups or for the one cup of Mac N Cheese that you have placed in the Backpack cupboard. And THANK YOU for your encouragement and inquisitive thoughts. YOU have made all this possible.
