



THIS DECEMBER AND INTO JANUARY, join us for Words for the Beginning: Advent Reminders for New Seasons.

The Words for the Beginning Advent series focuses on simple, enduring truths that offer comfort and guidance as we navigate life's endings and beginnings. Inspired by the image of a mother imparting wisdom to her child, the series explores themes such as blessedness as our starting point, the importance of community and support ("we can't go alone"), the call to make a positive impact ("do the good that is yours to do"), the courage to embrace hope even when it feels risky, the power of laughter and joy, the acceptance of life's unpredictable journey ("the road isn't straight"), and the assurance that God's love knows each of us personally ("love knows your name"). These themes are woven together like a quilt, connecting ancient scriptures with contemporary reminders to provide warmth and strength for the journey ahead.
